## WELCOME TO EKATERINBURG



#### Located at the meeting point of two continents, Ekaterinburg is among the five biggest cities of Russia.

It is an administrative, economic, scientific and cultural center of the Ural.

26 accredited consular posts, over 340 representative offices and branches of foreign companies are located here. It is the third (after Moscow and St. Petersburg) largest transportation hub of Russia. The main air gate of Ekaterinburg is an international airport «Koltsovo». It is one of the largest and most modern airports in Russia handling millions of passengers a year.

In 2014, Ekaterinburg became the third most popular Russian city among foreign tourists (after Moscow and St. Petersburg). There are over 600 monuments of history and culture.

**Each era of the city's history is embodied in its architecture:** the merchants' houses and old schools, strict constructivism and bold modern sculptures. The main attractions are linked by a tourist route 6.5 km long, called the «red line». You can complete it in about half a day, following the red markings on the road.

The city has about 50 different museums, over 10 theatres, the Sverdlovsk Film Studio, Philharmonic Hall, Zoo, Circus and other attractions.



# BEFORE AND UPON ARRIVAL



## Once nominated by their Home Institutions in the framework of International Exchange Programs, students should:

- Fill necessary documents to register at the USUE;
- Inform the international coordinator of USUE once your Russian visa is issued;
- Inform the international coordinator of USUE about the date and time of arrival in Russia at least 5 days prior;
- Send a scanned copy of the medical certificate translated into the Russian language with the results of the following medical tests: fluorography (chest X-ray), hepatitis B and C viruses (HBV and HCV), syphilis and dermatovenerologist check.

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINES:**

**Autumn semester:** May 31, 2020 **Spring semester:** October 31, 2020

#### AFTER THE ARRIVAL

- Once in Ekaterinburg, International Exchange students should go to the International Office of the USUE (8 Marta st., 62,office.354) for registration and should provide the following documents: passport, visa, migration card.
- According to the visa legislation of the Russian Federation, first students get the Russian visa only for 90 days, than it must be extended in Ekaterinburg: International department of USUE will do it before the end of the study period. This procedure will cost 2400 rubles or about 35 euro (HIV certificate and state fee).
- All foreign students should have a medical insurance. If you don't have it, you can make it in the International Office of the USUE. The price of the medical insurance is 3500 rubles (about 50 €).
